

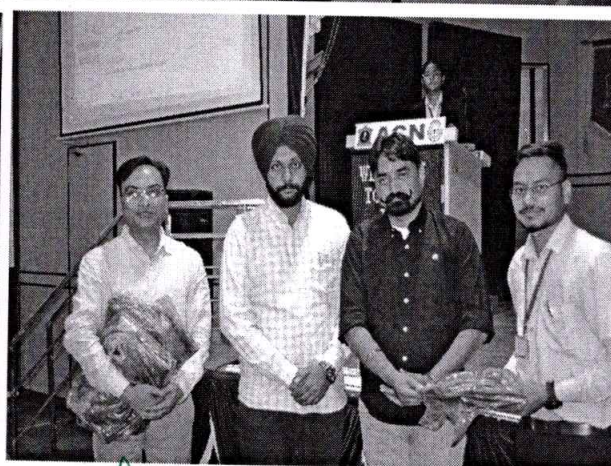
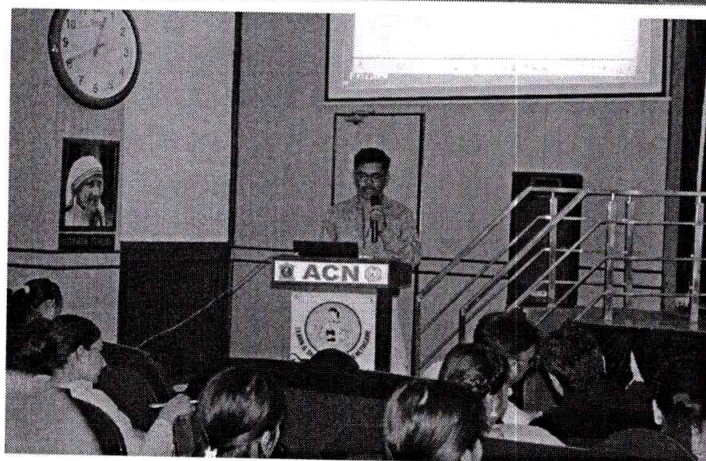
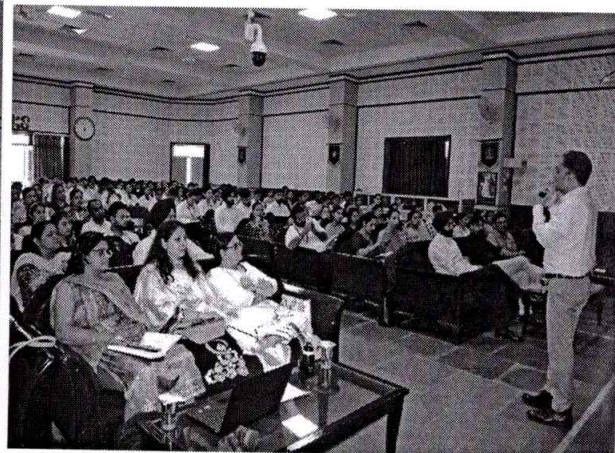
ARMY COLLEGE OF NURSING, JALANDHAR CANTT EBSCO ONSITE CLUSTER TRAINING

Baba Farid University of Health sciences, Faridkot conducted the training session of e-resources under HSLIBNET at **Army College of Nursing, JRC** on 04/04/2025. Mr. Lakhpat Singh and Mr Suresh Karly was the guest speakers of the event. The event was also graced by the University representatives Mr. Prabhjeet Singh Sandhu and Mr. Harjinder Singh. Fourteen colleges took part in the training. The total participants were 253 including staff and students. Mr. Lakhpat and Mr. Suresh Karly provided basic information about EBSCO and Medisys. EBSCO is a leading provider of research databases, e-journal and e-package subscription management, book collection development and acquisition management, and a major provider of library technology, e-books solutions for universities, colleges, hospitals, corporations, government and public libraries worldwide. They guided participants about EBSCO host and Medisys. The various resources available viz., Case Studies, videos, e-books/ Book chapters, journals, database, in EBSCO e-database. They explained about basic search and advanced search to the students. In advanced search he explained about how to use Boolean/ Phrase search, find all my search terms, find any of my search terms and Smart text searching to get maximum relevant information about subject. They made all the participants comfortable and they interacted with him by asking their queries pertaining to various e-resources and applications of e-database. They addressed all the queries satisfactorily and with an enthusiasm. At, the end they have conducted a quiz competition and distributed the prizes to the winners. This training session was helpful for participants to understand various e-resources available with EBSCO e-database and how to use it effectively for their research.
